- Minimum Daily Base Charge: \$0.33 up to \$0.50 based on plans
- Insufficient Funds or Returned Payments: \$30.00
- Premium Contact Fee via Telephone (1 free call per day): Up to \$5.00
- Credit/Debit card payments with live agent \$4.95 and or under minimum requirement.
- Refund Check Payment Charge (will be deducted from closeout balance prior to issuing a refund): Up to \$5.00
- Reconnect after tampering: \$350.00 (this may increase due to the utility company's total fees sent once all charges are calculated, these charges will be passed on at cost).

How will the company contact me for important notices?	We will contact you by text message or email for important notifications including current balance requests, payment confirmation, and disconnection warnings. Pronto Power may communicate additional time sensitive notifications through USPS.	
Disconnection:  How can I avoid having my electricity disconnected?	It is important to maintain an account balance at or above \$0.01 or your service may be disconnected. This is called a "disconnection balance."  You will be notified 1 day before your account balance is expected to fall below \$0.01.  If your account balance falls below \$0.01 more quickly than expected, service may be disconnected as little as one day after you receive the low balance notification.  Disconnect/Reconnect fee: Pronto Power does not charge a fee; however, the utility company may assess a fee that will be passed on to the customer at cost.	
Reconnection:  How do I restart  prepaid service if my  electricity is  disconnected?	If your service is disconnected, and your account has a negative balance, you must pay the negative balance and add \$20. The \$20 is not a fee, it is simply to bring your account positive \$20. In order to restart prepaid electric service, you must make a payment to establish a positive balance of \$20.00.  Disconnect/Reconnect fee: Pronto Power does not charge a fee; however, the utility company may assess a fee that will be passed on to the customer at cost	
Deferred Payment Plans: When is a deferred payment plan available?	<ul> <li>Deferred payment plans are available upon request in the following situations:</li> <li>If your account reaches a negative balance of \$50 or more during an extreme weather event.</li> <li>If a state of disaster has been declared in your area by the Governor of Texas and the Public Utility Commission requires that deferred payment plans be offered.</li> <li>If Pronto Power has underbilled your account by \$50 or more for reasons other than theft of service.</li> </ul>
